

OFFICIAL RULES

2009 Golden Gate Fields DRF Handicapping Contest

THE CONTEST:

There will be three separate contests to qualify for a spot in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship in Las Vegas. Using your skills on Friday, December 11, 2009, Saturday, December 12, 2009 or Sunday, December 13, 2009, participants will attempt to select the most WIN horses (officially finish first) in each of the races three through eight at Golden Gate Fields. The most fictional dollars earned based on a mythical \$20 win bet, for races three through eight will determine the winners on each day. The entry card will be valid only on the day that it is deposited. **One contest card per person per day, failure to comply will result in disqualification.**

- ❖ The person with the highest mythical total on Friday, December 11, 2009 will receive a paid trip to Las Vegas and a chance to compete in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship.
- ❖ The person with the highest mythical total on Saturday, December 12, 2009 will receive a paid trip to Las Vegas and a chance to compete in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship.
- ❖ The person with the highest mythical total on Sunday, December 13, 2009 will receive a paid trip to Las Vegas and a chance to compete in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship.

No mythical money earned in any of the contests will rollover. Each contest is a separate contest.

TO BE ELIGIBLE YOU MUST PERSONALLY DROP OFF YOUR ENTRY CARD AT GOLDEN GATE FIELDS FOR EACH OF THE CONTESTS ON FRIDAY, DECEMBER 11, SATURDAY, DECEMBER 12, OR SUNDAY, DECEMBER 13, 2009. If a tie exists for any placing on Friday, December 11, 2009, Saturday, December 12, 2009 or Sunday, December 13, 2009 a random drawing of names will take place to determine the winners. One winner per household will be eligible for a spot in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship.

TO ENTER:

Entries will be distributed one per person at the admission gates on Friday, December 11, 2009, Saturday, December 12, 2009 or Sunday, December 13, 2009 until **ten minutes prior to post time** of the third Golden Gate Fields race.

Completely fill out and deposit your Golden Gate Fields/DRF entry card in entry bins located in the Grandstand, Mezzanine level next to Customer Service, Club

House Rotunda next to Customer Service, and Turf Club entrance **five minutes prior to post time** of the third Golden Gate Fields race on Friday, December 11, 2009, Saturday, December 12, 2009 or Sunday, December 13, 2009. The entry card must have the official program entry numbers of the six horses you believe have the greatest chance to WIN in each of Golden Gate Fields races three through eight on each given contest day.

NHC TOUR MEMBERS:

All NHC Tour members must register each day with a tournament official at Customer Service and present a valid photo ID and Tour pin number before beginning play.

CONTEST ENTRIES AND DEADLINES:

Entries for each contest day must be personally deposited on the day of each contest, and must be done a minimum of five minutes before official post time of the third Golden Gate Fields race. Must be 21 years of age or older to participate. All rules and regulations from the National Thoroughbred Racing Association will also apply with this contest.

Winners must respond by December 20, 2009 in order to receive the paid trip to Las Vegas and a spot in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship. If the winner does not respond by December 20, 2009 or is unable to attend the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship, the next highest bankroll from that day's contest will be eligible to move up in rank. If a tie exists, another random drawing will be held.

SCRATCHES:

If a horse that corresponds to a numbered entry on a contestant's card is scratched at any time before the running of the designated race, the selection will be transferred to the starting favorite.

DEAD HEATS:

In the case of a dead heat, all official winners will be declared winners. The official tote board winning numbers will be declared contest winning numbers.

PRIZES:

There will be no cash prizes. The three prize winners will receive a paid trip to Las Vegas and a spot in the 2010 DRF/NTRA National Handicapping Championship. Hotel and airfare will be arranged and paid for by Golden Gate Fields personnel.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY:

There is no purchase necessary to participate in the 2009 Golden Gate Fields / DRF Handicapping Contest. Entries may be obtained at the Club House Admission Entrance from 9:00 A.M. until 10:00 A.M. on the mornings of Friday, December 11, 2009, Saturday, December 12, 2009 or Sunday, December 13, 2009.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTESTANTS:

Entrants must be 21 years of age or older. An affidavit will be required of all prize winners confirming compliance with both the rules of this contest and the rules provided by the National Thoroughbred Racing Association.

LEGIBILITY:

Pacific Racing Association assumes no responsibility for cards deemed illegible by contest officials. PRINT YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, CITY, PHONE NUMBER AND ZIP CODE CLEARLY.

AFFIDAVIT:

An affidavit confirming compliance of all rules of this contest and permission to use likeness for photographs and publicity will be required of all prize winners. Winning persons acknowledge that if they enter this contest under a fraudulent name and/or Social Security number, they will be immediately disqualified from this and all future contests held by Pacific Racing Association. Positive Identification is required of all prize winners. (Positive identification is a valid California Driver's License with a picture and the same address and birth date used on contest cards, and/or such other form of identification as deemed adequate by contest officials.)

DISQUALIFICATION:

Entry cards are only valid on the day that they are deposited. One contest card per person per day is allowed. Failure to comply with the Golden Gate Fields Official Rules will result in disqualification. In the event that a finalist is disqualified for any reason, any prize won by that finalist will be forfeited.

LIABILITY OF FEDERAL AND STATE TAXES:

Liability for any and all federal and state taxes is solely the responsibility of the prize winners. No prize money and/or prizes will be paid without social security numbers.
