## **BEST BET: Run Over You (2nd race)**

### **First Race: 1.Hava Java 2.Acekingqueenjacten 3.Sunset Tijuana**

HAVA JAVA had her two-race win streak snapped last time and drops back to the bottom level where she scored those two wins. Good speed and decent work since last start. Drawn outside ACEKINGQUEENJACTEN, her principal pace rival and the one she ran down two back when she pulled away to win by three lengths. 'Miss Straight' ran second against better last time against a sharp mare in her first start for new barn. She has run second in her past four starts preceded by a win. SUNSET TIJUANA takes off the blinkers today. Raced wide last time and may find herself caught wide here. Has pair of decent maintenance drills since her last start.

### **Second Race: 1.Run Over You 2.Salah Pick Six 3.Sir Wiggley**

RUN OVER YOU was overmatched in first start following a maiden win when asked to stretch out following solid sprint win. Fractions weren't bad in that race, and drop back to more realistic level may be all he needs. Definitely bred to be a sprinter. SALAH PICK SIX is also getting a significant drop here and has never run this cheap before. Claiming price cut in half as he comes north for the first time. Maiden win last year good enough to win here and comes here with sharp five-furlong work in his final prep. SIR WIGGLEY is another dropped, cutting his claiming price in half for his first start in nearly seven weeks. He's another that will appreciate the fact he is sprinting instead of routing, which proved a disaster two back.

### **Third Race: 1.Keyfargo 2.Flashy Helmsman 3.Glimmering Pete**

KEYFARGO bids for a hat trick here after being claimed from a victory at 18-to-1. Both wins have come at this distance. Is running in good form and has beaten better in the past. New barn wins 34 percent off the claim. FLASHY HELMSMAN was third behind the top pick last time. Ran second at this level in his previous start. Has stalking speed, and rail draw insures a ground-saving trip. Has hit the board in all four starts at this distance. GLIMMERING PETE is a veteran, who is worth a look at the bottom end of exotics. Coming north for the first time as he drops and makes first start of the year. Has pair of solid works during his break.

### **Fourth Race: 1.Made for Magic 2.Stanford Dolly 3.Rocket Kitty**

MADE FOR MAGIC dropped to this level and scored a nice win last time. Has sprinted primarily, but she has a first and a third in her only tries around two turns. Figures to get a good stalking trip and showed an ability to finish last time. STANFORD DOLLY stumbled badly, losing her rider last time to end a three-race win streak. Was reclaimed by barn she previously won for. Another runner that is comfortable running up front. Has run well here and won four of five races at this distance, losing only because of her stumble last time. ROCKET KITTY was favored when second to the top pick last time. She has a win and a second in her two tries for this tag. May be able to grab the lead here and will be tighter after troubled try in comeback try last time.

### **Fifth Race: 1.Count Me Twice 2. Papa's Sarahlin 3.R Mattie**

COUNT ME TWICE has run three times since spending 10 months on the sidelines. Has run all right against better. Has a seven-week layoff with two works, but barn wins 20 percent and shows a high ROI off similar layoffs. Worth look due to expected value. PAPA'S SARAHLIN was favored when dropped to this level last time. She stalked while a bit wide and didn't have much left late. Consistent check earner is a threat off her best and will be one the top pick has to catch. R MATTIE has done her best running here and has finished third for this tag in her past two starts. This is an easier condition, and she does have a maintenance drill since her last start.

### **Sixth Race: 1.Foggy Haze 2.Oh So Smooth 3.Tizzalating**

FOGGY HAZE is dropping after a stalking trip against better. Beaten favorite raced wide last time, which probably made the difference as she settled for fourth after losing a photo in her previous start. Figures to get another good stalking trip here as she drops to the bottom level for the first time. OH SO SMOOTH has hit the board in her past three starts running for this tag. Actually met better last time and matched her previous best Beyer. Running in good form right now. TIZZALATING just earned her diploma, going wire-to-wire in a bottom-level maiden claimer. Running at bottom level against winners and has two nice works since her victory.

### **Seventh Race: 1.Big Red Tate 2.Dance With Gable 3.Full Power Ahead**

BIG RED TATE is one head shy of three straight victories. Stalked nicely and scored game photo victory in debut for new barn in last start, beating several of today's rivals. Got big drop three back and got confidence-building victory. Has fired big in both starts since. DANCE WITH GABLE was the beaten favorite in the top pick's victory last out. He's a solid sprinter, who looms the one to catch. Has pair of solid works since raced and will try to improve on two straight seconds. He'll be a factor with his early foot and ability to finish. FULL POWER AHEAD ran third to the top pair last time and trailed the second choice in his previous start. Decent sprinter can't be overlooked as player in exotics.

### **Eighth Race: 1.Opal Haze 2.Lupita'sluckyangel 3.Alpine Yodel**

OPAL HAZE makes her debut here as she meets easier than she met down south. Has never won in U.S. since arriving here from Britain and Canada last year. Has cut out decent fractions in longer turf races down south, but both British wins did come on synthetic surfaces. Like the strong five-furlong work since the last race and the fact she might offer a bit of value. LUPITA'SLUCKYANGEL runs for a tag today. She's won at this level in two of her past three starts and has a win and a third in two starts here. Likes the distance, and outside post shouldn't prove a major drawback. ALPINE YODEL makes her first start in seven weeks but has been working regularly. Has been running on the turf, and, unlike the top pick, she's winless on synthetic surfaces. Beaten favorite in past two starts and entymate Mi Corredora is also trying to make amends as a beaten favorite.

### **Ninth Race: 1.Natpolean 2.Nail Polish 3.Ihopeigetit**

NATPOLEAN ran second as the odds-on pick in her debut here. Speedster draws rail again and seems much quicker than primary rival. NAIL POLISH, who also ran second as the favorite in her last start here. Moves to high-percentage barn that wins 32 percent with new faces and has easy maintenance drill since raced. Nail Polish has run second in her past three starts. Has a better last-race Beyer than the top pick, but will have that one to catch. Top pick gets five-pound weight break and should be able to control the pace off the last race. Note, however, that leading jockey rode both in their last start and chooses Nail Polish here. IHOPEIGETIT cuts back from a route to a sprint here and has a speed-sharpening three-furlong bullet since raced. Has shown speed in the past and is advantaged by being drawn to the outside.
